

# Spackle indicates when it's dry

Is it dry yet?

That may be one of the most frequently asked questions by a do-it-yourselfer, particularly for those who are trying to paint wall-repair spackling.

The problem is, how do you know for sure when it's dry enough to paint? Just feel it with your finger? Now there's a scientific test method.

It's DAP DryDex. It has a built-in dry time indicator right in the

paste.

It will change from pink to white to let you know when it's dry.
