APPLICATION

- 1. Surface should be clean, dry and free of all foreign material. Choose the BLEND STICK and Wood Stain Pen that most closely matches the surface to be repaired. Rub back and forth over imperfection until filled. Wipe surplus away with clean cloth and buff lightly. The Wood Stain Pen dries instantly and blends with most fine furniture; experiment first on a small section of wood.
- 2. For color blending, stroke in the direction of the grain; for scratches, stroke in the direction of the scratch. Immediately wipe with a clean cloth to remove excess stain. Repeat for deeper shades.
- 3. For deep holes and gouges, use the round end of the metal spatula to apply a Blend Stick shade. Use the straight edge to remove excess repair material. Remove any smudges by lightly buffing with a clean cloth.

TIP: Warm Blend Stick® in hand for a few minutes to soften before application. Best applied in temperatures between 65°F and 90°F.

- 4. For narrow cuts and deep scratches, briskly rub Blend Stick back and forth across the damage area, until it is completely filled. Then follow metal spatula directions above.
- 5. For burns, use the metal spatula to scrape the residue from the damaged area. Then follow directions for filling and finishing as noted above.
