

NEW HOME CONSTRUCTION WINDOW & DOOR 15 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

DAP Global Inc. warrants for a period of fifteen (15) years that its DAP Spec Line DYNAFLEX® 800 and DRAFTSTOP® 812 ("DAP Spec Line Products") will perform to DAP Global Inc.'s published, written product specifications found on its technical data bulletins and packaging in effect at the time of installation if used as directed, as indicated, within shelf life and when installed consistent with the terms and conditions set forth below in the installation of (1) new windows with flanges or mounting fins in new wood frame residential construction; or (2) new construction doors with mounting flange or brick mold in new wood frame residential construction.

WARRANTY COVERAGE

Under this 15 Year Limited Warranty, DAP Global Inc., as its sole and exclusive remedy, will reimburse the original purchaser of the DAP Spec Line Products, up to the value of \$10,000 per dwelling unit, for the reasonable cost of labor and materials to repair the window or door damaged as a direct result of the DAP Spec Line Products failing to perform to DAP Global Inc.'s published, written product specifications found on its technical data bulletins and packaging in effect at the time of installation (together, "failures"). As used herein, a dwelling unit is defined as: (1) a single-family detached home; or (2) a single-family attached home, such as a townhouse, duplex or rowhome. A dwelling unit, as used herein, does not include an apartment, condominium or similar structure, and this Limited Warranty does not apply to any apartment, condominium, or similar structure.

WARRANTY DURATION

The 15 Year Limited Warranty begins on the date on which the DAP Spec Line Products are sold to the original purchaser and continues for a period of fifteen (15) years from that date.

WARRANTY TERMS & CONDITIONS

To qualify for warranty coverage:

Windows:

1) The DAP Spec Line Products must be used as directed, as indicated, and within shelf life, 2) Windows must be new windows with flanges or mounting fins installed in new wood frame residential construction, 3) Windows must be installed in accordance with any one of the following methods: A) Window manufacturer instructions; B) FMA/AAMA 100-12 Standard Practice for Installation of Windows with Flanges or Mounting Fins in Wood Frame Construction for Extreme Wind/Water Conditions; or C) In accordance with industry standard ASTM E2112 section 8 through 8.1.1.3.4 for new construction windows, 4) Windows must be installed using Window Flashing Tape that meets AAMA standard 711—Voluntary Specification for Self-Adhered Flashing Used for Installations of Exterior Fenestration Products, Window Flashing Tape must be installed per ASTM E2112 section 8.1.1.1.4.

Doors:

1) The DAP Spec Line Products must be used as directed, as indicated, and within shelf life. 2) Doors must be new construction doors with mounting flange or brick mold installed in new wood frame residential construction. 3) Doors must be installed in accordance with any one of the following methods: A) FMA/AAMA/WDMA 300-12 Standard Practice for the Installation of Exterior Doors in Wood Frame Construction for Extreme Wind/Weather Exposure; or B) In accordance with ASTM E2112 Section 9.1.1 method A for doors with perimeter mounting flanges in drainage type wall construction. 4) Doors must be installed using Door Flashing Tape which meets AAMA Standard 711 - Voluntary Specification for Self-Adhered Flashing Used for Installations of Exterior Fenestration Products. Or Liquid Applied Flashing which meets AAMA 714 - Voluntary Specification for Liquid Applied Flashing Used to Create a Water- Resistive seal Around Exterior Wall Openings in buildings.

WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS

DAP Global Inc. shall not be responsible for failures caused by:

1) Improper storage, shipping, handling or installation of the windows, doors, flashing, DAP Spec Line DYNAFLEX® 800, or DRAFTSTOP® 812; 2) Improper use of DAP Spec Line DYNAFLEX® 800 and/or DRAFTSTOP® 812; 3) Neglect, abuse, improper design or improper construction of wall systems, windows and doors; 4) Acts of God, including but not limited to, hurricanes, tornadoes, floods, earthquakes, severe weather or other natural phenomenon; 5) Any failure of the installer to adhere to the instructions, warnings and limitations of any other product used during the installation of the window and/or door, including, but not limited to, house wrap and flashing tap; or 6) Any products installed in wall systems that do not allow for proper moisture management, such as Exterior Insulation and Finishing Systems (EIFS) or "synthetic stucco" without effective engineered drainage system.

ADDITIONALLY, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE INSTALLER, NOT DAP GLOBAL INC., TO:

(1) Install windows in accordance with window manufacturer instructions and industry standard FAM/AAMA 100-12 or ASTM E2112 for new construction windows and use Window Flashing Tape which meets AAMA 711; and 2) Install doors in accordance with the industry standard FMA/AAMA/WDMA 300-12 or ASTM E2112 for new construction doors and use flashing materials that meet AAMA 711 or AAMA 714 specifications. DAP Global Inc. will not be responsible for improper installation of the window and/or door systems.

REPLACEMENT WINDOW & DOOR 15 YEAR LIMITED WARRANTY

DAP Global Inc. warrants for a period of fifteen (15) years that its DAP Spec Line DYNAFLEX® 800, DYNAFLEX® 920, DRAFTSTOP® 812 ("DAP Spec Line Products") will perform to DAP Global Inc.'s published, written product specifications found on its technical data bulletins and packaging in effect at the time of installation if used as directed, as indicated, within shelf life and when installed consistent with the terms and conditions set forth below in the installation of (1) new windows with flanges or mounting fins in wood frame residential construction; or (2) new doors with mounting flange or brick mold in wood frame residential construction.

WARRANTY COVERAGE

Under this 15 Year Limited Warranty, DAP Global Inc., as its sole and exclusive remedy, will reimburse the original purchaser of the DAP Spec Line Products, up to the value of \$10,000 per dwelling unit, for the reasonable cost of labor and materials to repair the window or door damaged as a direct result of the DAP Spec Line Products failing to perform to DAP Global Inc.'s published, written product specifications found on its technical data bulletins and packaging in effect at the time of installation (together, "failures"). As used herein, a dwelling unit is defined as: (1) a single-family detached home; or (2) a single-family attached home, such as a townhouse, duplex or rowhome. A dwelling unit, as used herein, does not include an apartment, condominium, or similar structure and this Limited Warranty does not apply to any apartment, condominium or similar structure.

(1) Must be new windows with flanges or mounting fins installed in new wood frame residential construction. 2) Installed in accordance with any one of the following methods: a) Window manufacturer instructions; b) FMA/AAMA 100-12 Standard Practice for Installation of Windows with Flanges or Mounting Fins in Wood Frame Construction for Extreme WindoWater Conditions; or c) In accordance with industry standard ASTM E2112 section 8 through 8.5.3.2.5 for replacement windows, 3) Installed using Window Flashing Tape that meets AAMA standard 711– Voluntary Specification for Self-Adhered Flashing Used for Installations of Exterior Fenestration Products, Window Flashing Tape must be installed per ASTM E2112 section 8.1.1.1.4.

Doors:

(1) Must be new construction doors with mounting flange or brick mold installed in new wood frame residential construction. 2) Installed in accordance with any one of the following methods:
a) FMA/AAMA/WDMA 300-12 Standard Practice for the Installation of Exterior Doors in Wood Frame Construction for Extreme Wind/Weather Exposure; or; b) In accordance with ASTM E2112
Section 9.1.1 method A for doors with perimeter mounting flanges in drainage type wall construction. 3) Installed using Door Flashing Tape which meets AAMA Standard 711 – Voluntary Specification for Self-Adhered Flashing Used for Installations of Exterior Fenestration Products. Or Liquid Applied Flashing which meets AAMA 714 – Voluntary Specification for Liquid Applied Flashing Used to Create a Water-Resistive Seal Around Exterior Wall Openings in Buildings.

WARRANTY EXCLUSIONS
