WOOD FILLER TO THE RESCUE!













Tools you will need to repair your furniture:

DAP Plastic Wood Wood Filler Plastic Scraper tool 150 Grit Sandpaper

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The veneer had broken off in several places, leaving noticeable gouges in this dresser. We used DAP Plastic Wood Wood Filler, applied with a scraper in thin layers, to fill in the gouges.
- 2. Once dry, the Plastic Wood was sanded down using 150 grit sandpaper, which is pretty fine.
- 3. The drawer hardware was removed and the whole dresser was sanded down to remove the original gloss finish. The dresser was then wiped down to remove all sanding dust.
- 4. First the dresser was primed to ensure the paint will stick. Once dry, the dresser was painted with two coats of Sherwin Williams Canvas Tan.
- 5. To finish it off, a few light coats of satin Polycrylic were painted on to protect the paint. The hardware was given a new coat of spray paint to freshen it up.
