

# DIY Mountain Shelf

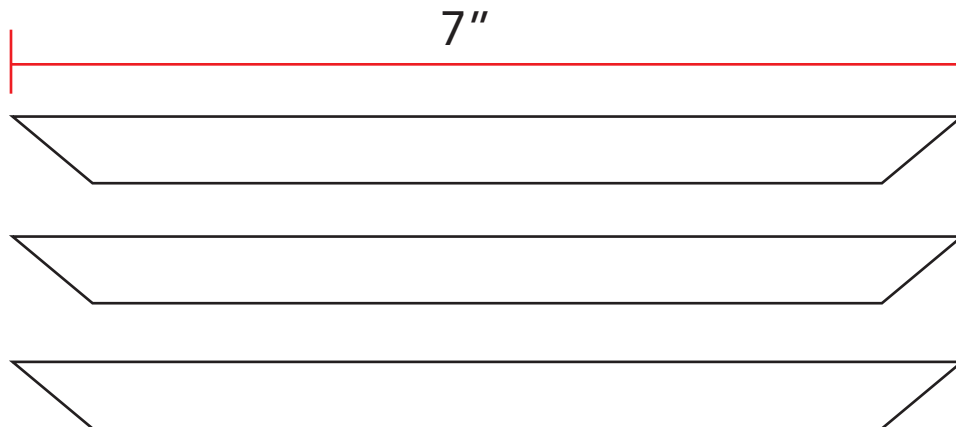


Items you will need to create a Mountain Shelf:

DAP Carpenter's Wood Glue  
(1) 1" x 3" x 6' pine board - will make 2-3 shelves  
Miter Saw  
Brad nailer and 1" brad nails

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut (3) pieces of pine at 7" long each. Use your miter saw to cut a 30 degree angle at both ends. The angles should both be facing inward, on the edge of the board, as shown below.



2. Apply a generous line of DAP Wood Glue to the edge of one board and press it to a second board edge, as shown. The pieces should fit together pinwheel style, as shown below.

3. Use your brad nailer and nail each end with three 1" nails.

4. Once the glue is dry, use painter's tape to create a graphic "mountain" look on the outside.

5. Hang on a wall or use on a bookshelf decoratively.
