It is ideal for filling and repairing concrete and cement cracks, including sidewalks, driveways, steps, patios and basements.

APPLICATION

Surface Preparation

- 1. Surface must be structurally sound and free of all foreign material.
- 2. If the crack is deeper than 1/4" (6 mm), user backer rod or sand to fill the crack to within 1/4" (6 mm) of the surface.

3. Deep cracks may require more than one application due to shrinkage while drying and will have extended drying times.

Application

- 1. Gently shake Liquid Cement bottle prior to opening and before each use to ensure consistent mixture.
- 2. Bottle nozzle should be snipped with scissors to initially open to make a 1/4" (6 mm) to 3/8" (9 mm) opening.
- 3. Fill crack in ¼ inch layers allowing at least 24 hours between applications.
- 4. For very thin cracks, Liquid Cement may be "pressed" or troweled flat into and around crack.

For Best Results

- 1. Do not apply in cracks wider than $\frac{1}{2}$ " (12 mm).
- 2. Apply Between: 45°F 100°F
- 3. Do not apply if rain is expected within 24 hours.
